

## GUIDE TO IMPORTANT CHANGES FOR RETURNING TO SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2020

Although you are coming back to school, the school day will not be as you have been used to in the past. This guide sets out the main changes. Remember there will be members of staff on duty to help you get to where you need to go. Please do not worry and ask a teacher if you get lost.

### Start times and first day timetable

### Year 7



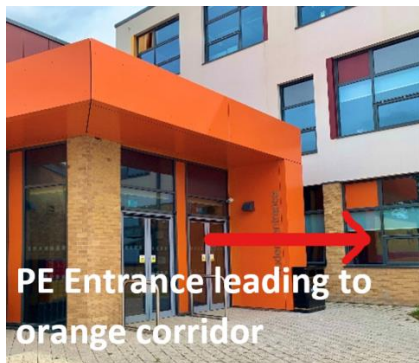
Blue corridor on the first floor

### Year 8



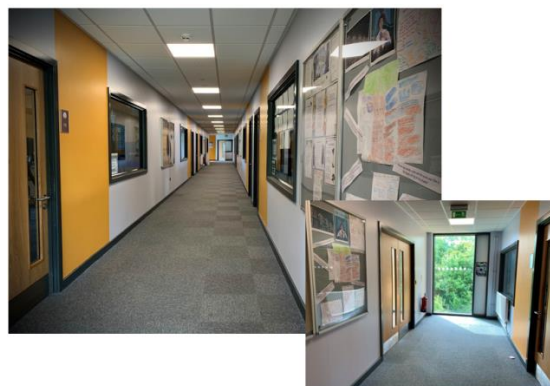
Green corridor on the second floor

## Lunchtime



Lunchtime will be split into four sittings so that all students can have access to hot food whilst at the same time allowing for furniture in the dining hall to be cleaned between sittings.

These are the only times food will be available in the canteen. The canteen will be closed before school, at break (11-11.20am) and after school. You can bring in your own snack to eat at break.

Full school uniform to be worn unless it is PE day.

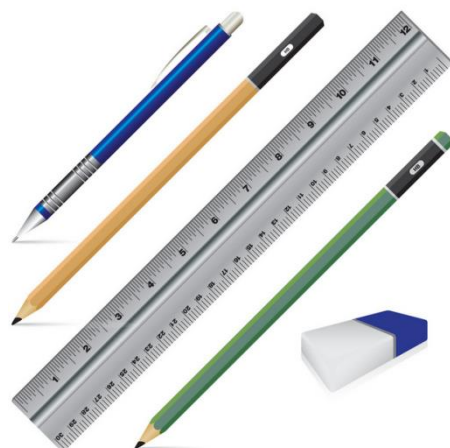
On the days that you have PE you need to attend in your school PE kit and allowed to wear plain coloured tracksuit bottoms over your PE shorts or skirt.

## Equipment
